Dear Craft Vendors:

The Village of Elmwood Park is proud to announce the Centennial Taste of Elmwood Park. In honor of our Centennial Celebration we have extended the Taste to be a four day event.

The dates and times are as follows:

Thursday, August 7th: 5:00 PM - 11 PM

Friday, August 8th: 5:00 PM - 11 PM

Saturday: August 9th: Noon - 11 PM

Sunday, August 10th: Noon - 10 PM

The Taste of Elmwood Park will again be held at Central Park at 75th Avenue and Fullerton. This year's Taste will be even bigger. In addition to closing 75th Avenue and Marwood, we will be closing a portion of Fullerton and 75th Avenue south to the alley. This will increase our event footprint and allow us to offer more to both participants and vendors. This year's Taste will also have a second stage, an expanded kids area and the Arts and Crafts Corner. The Arts and Craft corner is located at the northwest corner of Central Park.

The fee for the Arts and Crafts vendors will be \$100.00 for the four day event. You will receive a 10x10 space and 2-20amp outlets for a total of 40 amps of service. You will be allowed one power strip per booth for multiple use service. If however, your booth causes an overload of electrical usage and/or a power surge, which requires a service call to be placed, you will be held responsible to pay the bill for the electrician called out for service. We will need each vendor to supply a credit card number on their application. No charges will be applied, unless you are notified as such.

If you are interested in participating, please fill out the enclosed application. You need to submit the \$100.00 payment with the application. Depending on the amount of vendors received, we may need to have a selection process in place. If you are not chosen to participate, you will receive your payment back. Application deadline is Friday, May 30, 2014.

We look forward to having your participation in this wonderful event.
